Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.77 dated 15.08.2017, under Section 379-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (challan presented under Sections 379-B and 411 IPC), registered at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

Petitioner was arrested on 16.08.2017 and is in jail since then. Undoubtedly, the offence committed by the petitioner is serious, but then the petitioner ought to be given a chance to reform.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now, father of the petitioner has filed affidavit that he would keep surveillance on the petitioner and see that he do not commit similar offence.

Accepting the above affidavit as undertaking to this Court, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall deposit his passport, if possesses, with the trial Court. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
