Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.34, dated 02.09.2016, registered under Section 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

Vide order dated 30.11.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gobind Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not needed by the investigating agency for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 30.11.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
