The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.173, dated 13.09.2017, registered under Section 15/25/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention since 13.09.2017.

3. Admittedly, the contraband recovered from him and the co-accused is marginally above the commercial quantity. There is no indication of the petitioner's involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act prior to the date of the FIR in the present case.

4. In the circumstances, considering the long detention undergone
