DEEPAK SIBAL J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.83 dated 07.09.2014, registered under Sections 420, 465 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Bakshiwal, District Patiala and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

On December 01, 2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 19.12.2016 for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise/settlement, who in turn was directed to submit a report with regard to the number of persons arrayed as accused in FIR; whether any accused was proclaimed offender and whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

As directed, report dated 04.03.2017 from the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Nabha has been received, as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them and the petitioner, who is the only accused in the present FIR, has never declared as Proclaimed Offender.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR, in which the allegations pertain to a private dispute, the trial is at the initial stage and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal), 1052***, I deem it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.83 dated 07.09.2014, registered under Sections 420, 465 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Bakshiwal, District Patiala and all proceedings arising therefrom, qua the present petitioner.
