RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 152 dated 11.08.2015 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 324, 341 and 506 IPC (offence under Section 325 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 07.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 14.03.2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar and got recorded their statements qua compromise.

Report from the concerned Magistrate vide covering letter No. 216 dated

24.04.2017, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge,

Jalandhar, vide endorsement No. 949 G/JRK dated 24.04.2017 has also been received. According to the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, the compromise between the parties is voluntary, genuine, and without any pressure.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the petition is accepted and the aforesaid FIR No. 152 dated 11.08.2015 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner, is quashed.
