Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.529 dated
11.09.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 302, 323, 506, 120-B of Indian
Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station S.G.M. Nagar
Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the
depositions of the witnesses whose evidence has been recorded. Eye
witness-Bharat Bhushan Bhatiya son of Tek Chand Bhatiya has turned

hostile and has not supported the prosecution case being the only eye witness. Mother of the deceased has also turned hostile.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official states that there is no other case pending against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall file undertaking before the police station concerned that he will not commit/indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall deposit his passport, if possesses, with the trial Court. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
