ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.60 dated 14.08.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that 560 tablets of Tramadol along with 40 tablets containing Alprazolam were recovered from him. He further contends that Tramadol is not covered under the NDPS Act and total recovery of Alprazolam in terms of report of chemical examiner is 4.76 gms which is way below the threshold of commercial quantity of 100 gms. He is in custody since his arrest on 15.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, states that investigation has been completed and

challan will be filed shortly. He further states that as per the report of chemical examiner, recovery from the petitioner is 4.76 gms of Alprazolam.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the recovery from the petitioner is much below the threshold of commercial quantity and the petitioner is in custody for two and a half months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Gurjant Singh @ Janta is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
