Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jugal Kishore, Polic Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Mewat has duly conceded at the Bar that till date no incriminating evidence could be collected against petitioner-Brijesh Jindal @ Bikki as regarding the official issuance of receipts of the Indian Red Cross Society for enabling the person to get the driving licence and in the light of the same, the interim directions contained in the orders dated 15th February, 2017 passed by this Court are hereby made absolute.

In view of this, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.. Thereafter, the petitioner will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, it is made clear that the State is at liberty to seek recalling/modification of this order in case fresh evidence comes to light in this case.
