The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct an impartial and fair inquiry in FIR No.20, dated 19.02.2015, under Sections 326/323/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

On the last date of hearing i.e. on 09.02.2017, a complete copy of the petition had been furnished to learned State counsel and who had been directed to furnish a status report as regards the stage of investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is on instructions from ASI Baldev Raj, takes a stand that a compromise has since been arrived at between the parties. To substantiate such assertion, even the police file has been made available for perusal of this Court, which apparently contains a thumb marked statement of Joginder Kaur/present petitioner as also a statement of her daughter-in-law, namely, Gurmeet Kaur and which reflects that apparently a compromise has been arrived at. Learned State counsel further submits that the matter is now pending consideration before the Senior Superintendent of Police.

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State,
counsel appearing for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
