Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing respondent No.2 to look into the request dated 02.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioner and also direct respondents No.3 and 4 to serve an advance notice upon the petitioner as provided under Section 160 Cr.P.C. if he is required in any enquiry or investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the suit filed by respondent No.5, the plaint was rejected and even against the rejection of plaint, the appeal was also dismissed. The said respondent is making applications one after the other to the police. The SHO concerned has found no merit in the complaints so submitted by respondent No.5, but still the petitioner is being called by the DSP.

Since the petitioner is being called by the DSP, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 02.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar i.e. respondent No.2.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 4 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case including the contents of representation dated 02.09.2017 submitted by the petitioner, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into said representation dated 02.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
