JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.188 dated 17.09.2017, under Sections 498-A, 406, 376/511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating

Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.11.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
