With the efforts of counsel for the parties, parties have been able to arrive at a settlement. They have agreed to file a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage of the petitioner and complainant by mutual consent.

The petitioner shall pay an amount of Rs.6.5 lacs towards permanent alimony, maintenance to the wife as well as to the minor child born out of the wedlock.

Out of Rs.6.5 lacs, an amount of Rs.4.5 lacs shall be payable to the complainant and another sum of Rs.2 lacs in the shape of FDR under the guardianship of the mother shall be paid to the minor child. An amount of Rs.3 lacs shall be paid by the petitioner at the time of recording of statements of the parties in first motion. The remaining amount of Rs.1.5 lacs payable to the complainant shall be paid at the time of recording of statements of the parties in second motion. In addition, the fixed deposit receipt of Rs.2 lacs in the name of minor child shall be handed over to the complainant at the time of recording

of statements in second motion.

The complainant shall raise no objection for quashing the criminal proceedings lodged vide FIR No.73 dated 27.10.2016 under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot, District Pathankot and she will withdraw application filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. It has been agreed that there is no other litigation pending between the parties nor they will initiate any fresh litigation against each other.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.12.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions incorporated therein. The parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions settled before this Court.
