Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the basis of a complaint UID No. 1195940 dated 20.09.2017 filed by Seema respondent No.5, the petitioners have appeared before respondent No.3 i.e. ADCP/CAW & C. Cell Women Police Station, Ludhiana and have been appearing regularly as and when called.

The prayer of the present petitioners is that in case the Women Cell deems it appropriate to register an FIR against them, they may not be arrested without giving them notice in advance.

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Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court Mr. A.S. Dhaliwal, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply adequate number of copies of the petition to the State counsel during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

with a direction to respondents No. 1, 2 & 4 that in case the petitioners are to be arrested in connection with the complaint filed by respondent No.5 an advance notice of one week be given to them.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
