The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 84 dated 10.08.2017, under Sections 379, 188 of IPC, Sections 4(1), 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development Act), 1957, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that the sand was being illegally mined from 02 kanals of land which belongs to her. He further contends that petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court vide order dated 08.11.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rajender Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 08.11.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.11.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
