This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and also seeking direction to respondents No. 4 and 5 not to interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioner.

At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already approached respondent No. 2/Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar by way of a representation dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-2), however, no action has been taken thereon so far. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P. P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Let adequate copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made, let this petition itself be treated as representation and respondent No. 2/Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar is directed to decide the same within a period of one month on receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the petition.
