By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a complaint case No. 328 dated 19.02.2015 titled as Karnail Dass Vs. Balkar Singh, registered under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

It is contended that the order dated 09.02.2017 has been complied with and the petitioner has furnished fresh bail/surety bonds before the trial Court. He further states that the parties have compromised the matter and towards the compromise, the petitioner has offered Rs.50,000/- in cash which is paid to respondent No.2 in Court itself. The remaining amount shall be paid in quarterly

installments of Rs.50,000/- each.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned counsel for respondent No.2 accepts the proposal made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.02.2017, is made absolute. However, in case of any breach of the undertaking made before this Court, the present petition shall be deemed to be dismissed without further notice.

The petition stands allowed.
