The petitioner has filed the aforesaid petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.91 dated 28.06.2012 registered under Sections 302, 506, 307, 324, 427, 452, 148 & 149 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 and 30 of Arms Act at Police Station Mukeria, Hoshiarpur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Reply filed by the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while praying for regular bail, in the alternate prayed for interim bail for attending the marriage of son of the petitioner's sister to be solemnized on 30.12.2017.

It is not in dispute that the trial is almost at the stage of culmination and now fixed for only recording of statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C. In view of the fact that the FIR relates to murder, the regular bail cannot be granted to the petitioner. However, I am inclined to grant

interim bail to the petitioner for attending the aforesaid marriage of sister's son.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-42085 OF 2017 is disposed of.
- (ii) The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail under police custody for a period of two days (i.e. on 30.12.2017 and 31.12.2017) subject to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner be taken in custody to the place where the marriage is to be solemnized on 30.12.2017 on 9.00am and be taken back to the concerned jail on 31.12.2017 on 5.00pm.
