Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.127 dated 31.10.2016, registered under Sections 307, 427, 148,149 IPC and 24/27/54/59 Arms Act, at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

On 02.12.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had granted ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating officer subject to the condition prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and at this stage are no longer needed by the investigating agency for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 02.12.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made

absolute subject to the condition prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
