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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner claims that he had lodged FIR No. 225, dated 25.10.2017, under Section 323 IPC read with Section 452 IPC at Police Station Cantonment, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure-P-1) against private respondents. He is being harassed by official respondents to enter into compromise with private respondents and his house was raided. Petitioner has already made a complaint dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure-P-5) to Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, with a copy of the same to Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Mini Secretariat, Chandigarh, (Annexure-P-3).

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, alongwith his complaint dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure-P-5), who shall

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examine the complaint and take necessary corrective measures in accordance with law and ensure that petitioner is not harassed and compelled to enter into compromise with prive respondents.
