This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of the order dated 06.12.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pathankot in complaint case registered under Section 498-A whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to Annexure P-1 to contend that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties. The necessary payments have already been made in favour of the complainant. Even the complaint stands withdrawn which is reflected in Annexure P-2. In view of the same, the petitioner went abroad under a *bona fide* belief that he is no longer required in the matter.
