Reply on behalf of respondent No.11 filed in the Court
today is taken on record.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the parties and in
view of the concurrence shown by the counsel for the two sides that the
matter needs to be thoroughly probed and for which a Special Investigation
Team needs to be constituted.

In view of the concurrence with the consent of learned counsel for the two sides, a Special Investigation Team consisting of Mr. Nageshwar Rao, IPS, Director Vigilance Bureau, Punjab, Mr. Rohit Chaudhary, IPS, ADGP Railways Punjab and Mr. S. Bhoopathi, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala is constituted, who will probe into the entire allegations levelled by the petitioner and for which they will be at liberty to get medical opinion from the appropriate authorities preferably of Government organisation of repute. The Special Investigations Team upon completion of investigations will submit its report to this Court preferably within a period of two months from the day the SIT is constituted.

Director General of Police, Punjab to pass appropriate orders in the light of these directions.

Let necessary intimation be sent to the officer concerned.

The petition stands disposed off in those terms.
