Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.152 dated 09.09.2017 registered under Sections 420, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Nahianwala, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that in compliance of order of this Court dated 17.11.2017, to show his bonafide the petitioner has deposited Rs.2 lakh before the trial Court and the same

has been converted into STDR by the trial Court. Final report under Section

173 Cr.P.C. has been filed and conclusion of trial shall take a long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any further in jail.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
