Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is the sister-in-law of the complainant who is residing abroad. She has already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.12.2016 and is ready to face the proceedings, in accordance with law, without any default.

Counsel for the State has submitted that the husband, parents-in-law of the complainant and complainant herself are residing abroad.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of. Interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.12.2016 is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) she shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) she shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
