It is the contention of the petitioner that he is being unnecessarily harassed and threatened by respondent No. 3, who is a Local Level Police Officer, at the instance of private respondents No. 4 to 6. He has, therefore, approached this Court for a direction to restrain the respondents from harassing or humiliating him any further.

4. After hearing Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the petitioner's allegations, the matter is disposed off with a direction upon respondent No. 2 to examine the

petitioner's grievances as conveyed in this petition and to ensure thereafter that he is not put to any unnecessary harassment and in the event of any actual criminal complaint having been lodged upon him, adequate notice under Section 160(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure be given to him.
