This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of the order dated 02.08.2010 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Addl.Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person in FIR No.133 dated 06.07.2007 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 351, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two of the co-accused stand acquitted vide judgement dated 06.09.2012 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Addl.Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar as the identity of the accused could not be established. The petitioner was not aware of the factum of the registration of the FIR.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Gulnoor Ghuman, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the

paper book has been furnished to the learned counsel, in the Court.

In this view of the above, in case the petitioner surrenders before the competent Court within 04 weeks' from today, he be admitted to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
