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**LISA GILL, J.**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 326 dated 06.10.2017 under Sections 323, 452, 506, 354B, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mohindergarh.

It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. They are the wives of Ram Niwas and Virender, co-accused respectively. The co-accused Virender and Ram Niwas, it is submitted, have been granted the concession of bail pending trial by the learned trial Court. The petitioners have joined investigation pursuant to interim order dated 16.11.2017 passed by this Court. They undertake to face the proceedings and not abuse the concession of anticipatory bail, if confirmed. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Pritam, affirms and verifies that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required. No recovery is to be effected from them.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 16.11.2017 is made absolute.
