The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.128 dated 17th June, 2016, registered under Sections 302, 201, 34, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Narwana Sadar, District Jind (Haryana).

Heard both sides.

The petitioner stands on identical footing with co-accused Ram Mehar @ Kala and Bhoop Singh @ Deva, who have already been granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench as well as this

Court in **CRM-M No.30848 of 2017** and **CRM-M No.41431 of 2017** respectively. The detailed reasons for release of the co-accused Ram Mehar @ Kala are mentioned in the order of the Co-ordinate Bench dated 7th October, 2017 (Anneuxre P-6), which are fully applicable to the present petitioner as well.

The present petitioner, namely Dinesh Kumar, may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to the condition that the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or otherwise influence or threaten the prosecution witness(s) including the complainant.
