Mr. Ved Parkash, Advocate, appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw his Power of Attorney from this petition as the petitioner does not wish that he should pursue the matter any longer. Allowed to do so.

Petitioner- Ashutosh, duly identified by Mr. Ved Parkash, Advocate, is present in Court. He has produced his Aadhar Card for identification purposes. A photocopy of the same is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Notice of motion was issued to respondent No. 2 to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement subject to deposit of Rs. 25,000/- as litigation expenses. The said amount has not been deposited. Consequently notice has not been issued to respondent No.2. The petitioner submits that he does not wish to pursue this petition and he may be permitted to withdraw the same. An affidavit of the petitioner- Ashutosh, dated 07.03.2017, to this effect has been filed in support of CRM No. 8166 of 2017, for withdrawal of this petition.

Accordingly, petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
