Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 307, 326, 325, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that so far as petitioner No.1-Gurjant Singh is concerned, he is stated to have given a gandassi blow on the person of Rasal Singh on his ring finger and the said injury has been declared as simple. Similarly, petitioner No.2-Gurpreet Singh @ Sonu is stated to have given injury with gandassi blow on the person of Luvdavinder Singh on his right wrist and below the knee and the said injuries are also stated to be simple in nature. She further states that pursuant to the order dated 09.11.2017 passed by this Court, petitioners

have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 09.11.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
