ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 43, dated 17.02.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner, who is daughter-in-law of the complainant, is that she was harassing the deceased, who is the son of the complainant and due to harassment, he had committed suicide. He further contends that the allegation, prima facie, do not constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC and no suicide note has been recovered. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 01.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sulakhan Singh, states that the investigation has been completed and the charges have been framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the fact that the investigation has been completed and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Rozi Rani is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
