This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 680 dated 20.10.2017, under Sections 323, 354-B, 427, 452, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the investigation in this case is complete. He also contends that the challan has already been filed on 10.11.2017. Counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 20.10.2017 and since the trial is likely to take some time, he would be entitled to be enlarged on regular bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. She opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in general.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of

the fact that petitioner is in custody since 20.10.2017, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars furthermore since the trial of the case is likely to take some time.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/learned trial Court concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
