INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners, Satnam Singh Kahlon, P.K.Kaushal, Bachitter Singh and Parduman Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 13.05.2014, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the trial Court. Earlier, the

petitioners were found innocent during the investigation.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 02.12.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and have been released on bail. They are now not required for custodial interrogation or investigation purposes. They have only to face the trial. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 02.12.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
