FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this second regular bail application are that while facing trial on 16.09.2015 petitioner absented before the trial Court and thereafter was declared Proclaimed Offender on 18.03.2016 and has sought regular bail upon his arrest.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is behind the bars since long time and has made prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner which is opposed by learned State counsel.

Appreciating the same, in view of the fact that the petitioner is a proclaimed offender which as per the own admission of the learned counsel for the petitioner subsists as on date and in view of the settled proposition of law proclaimed offender is not entitled to any such relief impels this Court to dismiss the present petition.
