Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.477 dated 28.07.2016 under
Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines,
District Hisar.

Notice of motion was issued and learned State counsel as well
as learned counsel for the complainant appeared.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned
State counsel and have gone through the record.

The petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are

for the complainant as well as learned State counsel, on the instructions of Investigating Officer, stated that the parties have effected compromise.
