Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for transfer of investigation of case FIR No.195 dated 21.08.2017 under Section 302 IPC registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) to some independent agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that Kuldeep Singh, who was brother of the petitioner, has died because of the injuries caused by the accused, but despite the FIR in question having been registered on 21.08.2017, investigation in the case is being conducted at a slow pace and for this reason, the accused are roaming freely. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.6 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to consider the representation dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) made by the wife of deceased Kuldeep Singh.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 7 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any comment on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.6 to consider the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
