The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No.228 dated 13.08.2017, registered under Sections 323 and 354 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Sultanpur Lodhi, Distict Kapurthala.

Heard.

On 10.11.2017, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.2 i.e. Sukhpreet Singh.

Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.2, namely, Sukhpreet Singh.

Notice of motion qua petitioner No.1 for 05.12.2017.

Petitioner No.1 is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.11.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed in the above terms.
