**Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner has informed this Court that now the police has registered an FIR No.806 dated 10.10.2017 at Police Station City Sirsa under Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act and under Sections 409, 467 and 120-B IPC and investigation is being carried out. The wife of the petitioner has also been made accused. It is further contended that the accused are still working at the same place. They have not been suspended or transferred.

In these circumstances, let Department concerned to examine as to what action is to be taken against the defaulting employees. Regarding name of wife of the petitioner as co-accused, she can avail the appropriate remedy under the law.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of.
