The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 136 dated 16.10.2017 under Sections 323/324/506/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Division No. 2, District Pathankot, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he had raised a lalkara and no injury is attributed to him.

This Court, by the order dated 10.11.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI

Ramesh Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 10.11.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 10.11.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
