The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 12 dated 25.03.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC, at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that after the case had been registered, the petitioner was released on bail, however, he was not able put in appearance on 17.08.2017, as a result of which, his bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him returnable for 14.09.2017. It is contended that the petitioner was unable to appear before the trial Court due to medical reasons, however, he has been appearing on each and every date. Now, PO proceedings have been initiated against him under Section 82 Cr.P.C. Counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner is ready to face trial but on account of cancellation of the bail order, he apprehends his arrest.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner and in view thereof, the arrest of the petitioner is stayed for a period of one week from today. He is directed to appear before the trial Court within this period and on his appearance, the trial Court shall grant him bail on his furnishing **heavy** personal bonds and surety to its satisfaction. In case, the petitioner does not appear before the trial Court within the stipulated time, the interim protection granted today shall stand vacated automatically.

Petition stands disposed of.
