**LISA GILL, J. (Oral)**

The petitioners in both the above said petitions seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0051 dated 07.06.2016 under Sections 306, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar.

It is submitted that the above said FIR was registered due to

some misunderstandings between the parties. CRM-M-41959 of 2016 has been filed for quashing of the aforesaid FIR. The petitioners, it is submitted, have joined investigation pursuant to orders dated 01.12.2016 and 05.12.2016.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Tarlok Singh, informs that the petitioners have joined investigation pursuant to interim orders passed by this Court. They are not required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that his client has no objection in case the present petitions are allowed.

There is no allegation that the petitioners are likely to abscond and not be available to face trial or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts before the learned trial Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without commenting on the merits of the case, it is considered just and expedient to allow these petitions. Consequently, order dated 01.12.2017 in CRM-M-42751-2016 and order dated 05.12.2016 in CRM-M-43424-2016 are made absolute.
