INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Jasbir Singh and Kamal Kumar, have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.42 dated 24.03.2016, registered at Police Station Saha under Sections 148, 323, 452, 506 and 307 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Narender Singh, Advocate has appeared and filed vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned

State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the learned trial Court, as they were found innocent during investigation.

Though, as per FIR, the present petitioners along with co-accused caused the injuries, but the injury declared dangerous to life has not been specifically attributed to them.

Furthermore, in view of order dated 13.02.2017, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail and now they have only to face the trial. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 13.02.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
