The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 773 dated 19.08.2017 under Sections 3/4/5/7/8 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Chandani Bagh, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has been arraigned as an accused being the lease holder of the Spa, which is further sublet, where objectionable activity was going on. He is stated to be in custody for over two months ever since his arrest on 05.09.2017. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar submits that investigation has been completed and challan has been filed in Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that investigation has already been completed and the petitioner is in custody for over two months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Sanjay, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
