Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.55 dated 07.04.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

As per prosecution version an alleged recovery of 177 strips (1770 tablets) of Emzlam was effected from the petitioner.

Report of the Chemical Examiner reveals the same to be containing the salt of Elprazolam. The alleged recovery would be construed to be commercial in nature.

In the light of such heavy recovery and the specific bar envisaged under Section 37 of N.D.P.S Act, this Court would not be inclined to entertain the prayer for regular bail.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
