Petitioner – Mohinder Pal has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 with a prayer that respondent no.2 be directed to get the matter i.e. FIR No.0191 dated 01.11.2016 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 380, 452 and 447 IPC registered at P.S. Phase-I, SAS Nagar (Mohali) investigated thoroughly.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Alam Vijay Singh, PPS, D.S.P., City-I, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), which is taken on record. He has submitted that while the investigation in the present FIR was underway, the accused moved a representation before the SSP, Mohali and accordingly, the inquiry was entrusted to SP City-I, District SAS Nagar, who after associating both the

sides has found that the compromise/agreement between the parties was disputed by the accused. During the pendency of the inquiry, the petitioner appeared before the Alam Vijay Singh, PPS, D.S.P., City-I, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) and requested for transfer of inquiry from SP City-I, Mohali to some other officer and accordingly, the inquiry was further entrusted to DSP, City-I, Mohali.

The DSP, City-I, District Mohali commenced with the inquiry by associating both the parties and afforded them opportunity of being heard. Accordingly, cancellation report of FIR in question is likely to be presented before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Since the police has completed the investigation and cancellation report is being submitted in the case, no further direction is required to be issued in the present petition.
