Pursuant to the order dated 21.08.2017, learned counsel for respondent No.1 has filed affidavit of Rajesh Choudhary, Executive Officer, Hoshiarpur Improvement Trust, Hoshiarpur, which is taken on record. Copy furnished.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the matter arising out of the same acquisition i.e. Civil Revision No.3431 of 1997 [**Mohinder Singh v. Hoshiarpur Improvement Trust, Hoshiarpur**], this Court, while relying upon a decision of the Supreme Court dated 20.07.1988 in Civil Appeal No.3017 of 1979 [**Mohinder Singh v. The Hoshiarpur Improvement Trust & Anr.**], had enhanced the compensation awarded to the claimant-land owners to ₹ 60/- per sq. yard. Thus, he submits that the petitioners even in the present writ petition are entitled to the same compensation.

The factual position, as set out above, is not disputed by learned counsel for respondent No.1. He rather submits that let the petition be disposed of in the same terms.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of in terms of the decision rendered by this Court in Mohinder Singh's case (supra).
