The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code (in short Cr.P.C) for quashing of the order dated 06.09.2011 (Annexure P-5) passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ferozepur whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in complaint No.384-1 dated 10.11.2009 titled as "Arvinder Singh Vs. Gurdev Singh etc" registered under Sections 302, 307, 427, 435 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

The petitioner earlier approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M-557-2017 under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail and the same was dismissed by holding that the

petitioner has been evading the process of the Court. Therefore, after taking a lenient view, it was ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within two weeks and prefers an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously. In pursuance thereof, the petitioner has not appeared before the trial Court and availed the order.

Therefore, no case for interference is made out.

The petition stands dismissed.
