Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.156, dated 18.09.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 100 grams of contraband was effected from the petitioner.

As per chemical examiner report, the salt of diphenoxylate hydrochloride has been detected. The same would be construed as commercial quantity.

Under such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner, benefit of regular bail.

Petition dismissed.
