Learned State counsel has informed that report from Forensic Science Laboratory, Punjab, SAS Nagar has been received, copy of which has been placed on file.

I have gone through the record.

By way of filing the petition, petitioner – Surinder Singh has prayed for issuance of directions to State of Punjab through Secretary to Government, Home Department, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh, Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar, District Kapurthala (respondents No.1 to 3) to hold an inquiry into execution of sale deed bearing document No.1881 dated 20.7.2012 registered in the office of Sub-Registrar

(respondent No.4) and for registration of case against the persons found guilty especially respondents No.4 to 7.

When the petition came up for hearing, notice thereof was issued to the respondents, who put in appearance through counsel. Thereafter, the case is being adjourned time and again and some sort of inquiry is being conducted at the level of this Court. In my view the same is not required since the petitioner has neither made any request in that regard nor the same is required to be done by this Court

Therefore, the petition stands disposed of directing SSP, Kapurthala (respondent No.2) to look into the grievances of the petitioner as regards the sale deed in question in light of representation Annexure P-4 and then to take suitable action in the matter, if the circumstances so warrant. Respondent No.2 would give notice of the enquiry to private respondents No.4 to 7 and would associate them therewith so that the version of both the sides comes up before him and proper inference can be reached. The exercise be completed within three months of the receipt of certified copy of the order.
