Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.131 dated 11.10.2016, under Sections 399, 402 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Bhupinder Singh who is stated to be running an Arms shop at Sangrur. Allegations were of certain fire arms and ammunition having been stolen.

Petitioner was arrested on 11.10.2016.

As per prosecution, recovery of .32 bore revolver and 2 live cartridges has been effected from the petitioner.

Co-accused Narinder Singh @ Kala and from whom recovery of .22 bore fire arm and live cartridge was effected has been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order dated 23.02.2017 in CRM No.M-5056 of 2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already

stands presented. Charges are yet to be framed.

Trial as such would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
