H.S. MADAAN, J. (Oral):

Petitioner-Rajinder Kumar, an accused in FIR No. 179 dated 21.06.2001 for offences under Sections 279 and 338 of Indian Penal Code (hereinafter referred to as 'IPC'), Police Station focal point, Ludhiana, had been facing trial in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana and during trial, he jumped bail, as such was declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 31.01.2007.

It is stated by counsel for petitioner that the matter had been compromised between the parties in claim petition and counsel for the petitioner had informed him that there was no necessity for him to attend the Court proceedings. He came to know much later that he had been declared a proclaimed offender in the criminal case, as such, has filed the present

petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

After hearing the counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to appear in the trial Court within a week from today and move an application for regular bail, which will be decided within seven days thereof. Till then, he may not be arrested in that case.
